



Member Engagement/Relationships Task Force Charging Document

Purpose

The Member Engagement/Relationships Task Force designs, oversees, and evaluates the impact of initiatives and activities intended to increase and improve the quality of members' engagement with NNECOS.

Chair and Members

The Member Engagement/Relationships Task Force should be comprised of at least 4 Board and non-Board members, one of whom is a NAHPAC member and one an allied health professional who is not currently a member of NAHPAC.

The Task Force Chair is appointed annually by the Programs & Services Steering Committee Chair with preference given to individuals who have experience serving on the Task Force. The Programs & Services Steering Committee Chair and the Executive Director serve as ex officio members of the task force.

Responsibilities & Guidelines

The Member Engagement/Relationships Task Force develops, implements, and reviews the impact of engagement programs and efforts.

The Task Force meets at least semi-annually via electronic communication or in person as is most appropriate. Members will be notified in advance of all meetings.
